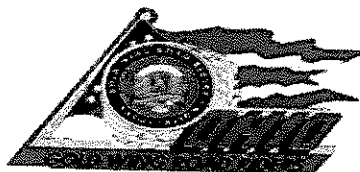
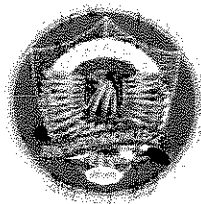

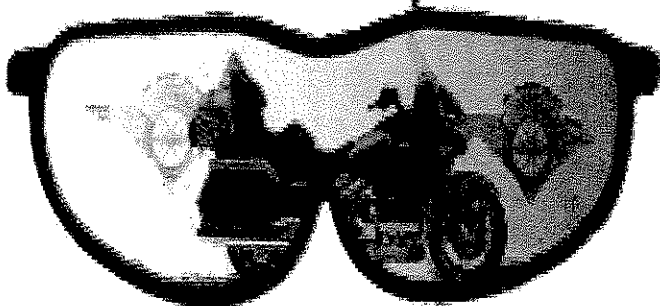

Well, spring is here and now everyone is getting those bikes out and have started riding. Watch for loose stone on corners and intersections because spring brings those awful orange barrels, detours and construction. All things that can be hazard to bike riders. One other topic that I have been asked to enclose is the NO Phone Zone pledge. Many of us have the hands free devises for our phones but for those of us that do not, stuffing the phone in ones helmet and driving can be a distraction while drive your bike down the road and the use of a hand that is needed while driving. Please pull off if you must use your phones.



GWRRRA is pleased to announce it will be participating in the "No Phone Zone" Program as seen on the popular Oprah program. One of GWRRRA's Chapter Rider Educators from Chapter D-2 in Indiana, Dave Williams, suggested we try to get as many GWRRRA Members, as well as non-Members, to sign the "No Phone Zone" pledge.

The pledge merely states that you will not drive a vehicle while texting, or use a cell phone and that you will encourage others to not talk on a cell phone or text while driving. Or, you will use a handsfree device while driving. It also states that if you must use a cell phone while driving you will safely pull over to the side of the road. Please remember to sign a pledge form only once!

This Program will be run under GWRRRA's Rider Education Program, specifically the Motorist Awareness Division. Charles Mallett, MAD Director, will oversee the Program and coordinate it through all our Rider Educators, as well as all the other divisions.

GWRRRA's goal is to get 100,000 pledges signed. This Program will kick off at Wing Ding 32 in Des Moines, Iowa. I also need a head count for the Bus Tour I will be setting up to do in Gettysburg.

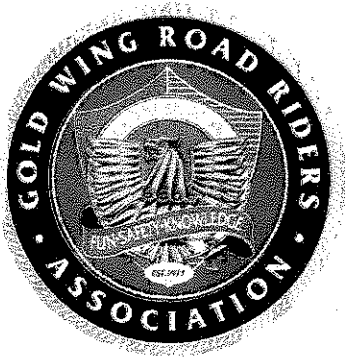
